Worried About Not Working?

Being injured on the job can create anxiety for both the injured employee and the employer. Employees worry about recovering from their injuries, losing their jobs and falling behind in their skills, careers and finances. Employers worry about lost work time, high turnover, increased workers' compensation claims, training costs and overtime pay.

Time Is Essential.

The key to a successful return to work is a quick referral to a Texas Workforce Solutions-Vocational Rehabilitation Services (TWS-VRS) counselor. **Do not wait to contact TWS-VRS.** Employees who are referred to a TWS-VRS counselor within three months of their injury have a greater chance for success than those who are not. Injured employees should start planning their return to work while still recuperating from their injuries.

How We Can Help.

TWS-VRS can help injured employees get the services they need to get back to work. In addition to counseling and guidance from qualified TWS-VRS counselors, services may include:

- Assessment of your disability and how it affects your ability to work
- Coordination between physician, employer, insurance company, etc
- Recommendations for workplace accommodations that could help you return to work sooner
