Take Charge of Business at Texas Business Conference in Horseshoe Bay

AUSTIN – The Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) will host Horseshoe Bay-area employers, human resource professionals, business owners and managers at the Texas Business Conference employment law update on Friday, Feb. 6, at the Horseshoe Bay Resort. The conference will provide valuable information for employers and business owners concerning the legal issues associated with operating a business in Texas.

Employers will receive practical, up-to-date information for operating a successful business and techniques to more effectively manage employees. Seminar topics will include: Texas employment law and the basics of hiring; federal and Texas wage and hour laws; the unemployment claim and appeal process; independent contractors; and employee policy handbooks.

Participants will receive the latest edition of the popular publication *Especially for Texas Employers*, which addresses basic legal issues regarding hiring, post-employment and work-separation policies. Certified public accountants who attend can earn six hours of continuing education credit, and other conference participants may qualify for general professional credit.

The conference is from 8:30 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. at the Horseshoe Bay Resort in the Granite Ballroom, located at 200 Hi Circle North.
