


- Used to describe a local area's economic picture







- Texas annual job growth is lower after nearly 100,000 less combined jobs in two major industries.




Austin-Round Rock MSA vs. Texas Industry Composition











Annual Growth Rate for Total Nonagricultural Employment












Ranked by 2014 Employment with 2014 Average Wages

Largest Associate's Degree Occupations


Ranked by 2014 Employment with 2014 Average Wages





Rural Capital Area WDA

Ranked by 2014 Employment with 2014 Average Wages








Texas Cities with the Largest Over-the-Year Unemployment Rate Decreases

December 2014 - December 2015






Texas Industry Composition

Total Employment








