College Credit for Heroes is a workforce development initiative designed to recognize the exceptional knowledge and skills gained by uniformed service members. The program awards you college credits for your military experience and offers accelerated degrees, workforce certificates, and licenses, allowing you to more quickly and easily transition into the civilian workforce. The program is administered by the Texas Workforce Commission.

- ★ School of Manufacturing and Industrial Technology



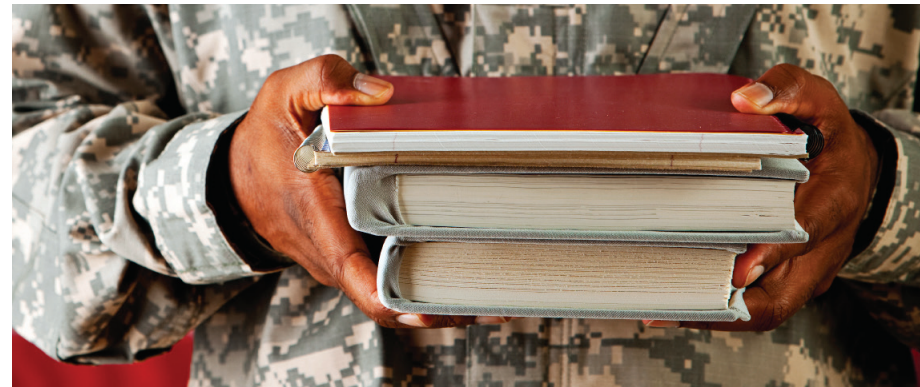
