I am a *veteran* or a *transitioning service member* who:

- served on active duty more than 180 days and received other than a dishonorable discharge;
- was discharged/released from active duty because of a service-connected disability; or
- was a member of a Reserve/National Guard component called to active duty; served during a period of war, or in a campaign, or expedition for which a campaign badge is authorized; or was released from active duty by reason of sole survivorship discharge.

***IF THE FOLLOWING APPLY TO YOU, PLEASE INFORM THE RECEPTION STAFF.***

I am a *spouse* of:

- a veteran who died of a service-connected disability;
- a veteran who has a total disability rating resulting from a service-connected disability;
- a veteran who died while a service-connected disability was in existence; or
- an active duty service member who for more than 90 days is/was listed as:
  - missing in action;
  - captured in the line of duty by hostile forces; or
  - forcibly detained or interned in the line of duty by a foreign government or power.

I am a *spouse* or other *family caregiver* of a wounded, ill, or injured veteran, to include:

- a caregiver—an individual who provides personal care services to the veteran;
- a family caregiver—a family member who is a caregiver of the veteran; or
- a family member—who is a member of the family of the veteran (including a parent, spouse, child, step-family member, and extended family member) or who lives with, but is not a member of, the family of the veteran.

**To serve you better, please indicate whether any of the following applies to you.**

It is not necessary to inform the reception staff which of these factors may apply to you—***only inform them if one or more of the factors do apply.***

One or more of the following apply to me:

- Special disabled or disabled veteran (entitled to compensation from the US Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), would be entitled to compensation except for the receipt of military retirement pay, separated from active duty because of a service-connected disability, or has a pending disability claim with the VA)
- Recently separated from active duty within the last three years and have been unemployed 27 weeks or more in the last 12 months
- A veteran lacking a high school diploma or equivalent certificate
- A low-income individual (This determination is based on where you live and the size of your family. If you aren't sure, ask the front desk or a staff member.)
- Homeless individual or at risk of being homeless (includes those fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence)
- An offender who is currently incarcerated or who has been released from incarceration
- A veteran between the ages of 18 and 24
- A veteran who served during the Vietnam era, which means I served on active duty in the military, naval, or air service at any time during the period beginning February 28, 1961, and ending May 7, 1975
- A transitioning service member in the US Armed Forces who:
  - has been identified as needing individualized career services or case managed services;
  - is a member of the US Armed Forces and is wounded, ill, or injured and receiving treatment in a military treatment facility or a warrior transition unit;
  - has not met the Career Readiness Standards, as documented on Form DD-2958, Service Member Career Readiness Standards/Individual Transition Plan, signed by my commander;
  - is between the ages of 18 and 24; or
  - is being involuntarily separated through a service reduction-in-force.
