



The Lone Star Workforce of the Future Fund (LSWF) is a program to increase the supply of qualified workers for entry-level to mid-level jobs in high demand occupations. LSWF will help ensure the Texas workforce is capable of filling available and emerging jobs in the state. Program parameters:

- Cost per trainee up to \$7,500
- Grants up to \$250,000
- 40% of project funding must come from a source other than state government
- At least 50% of program participants must be placed into high demand occupations that earn a selfsufficient wage

Who is Eligible to Apply?

Public community or technical colleges and nonprofit organizations are invited to apply.

Who Can Be Trained?

Individuals who are under-employed or unemployed.

First-Come, First-Served

Funds are available for qualifying applications until they run out.
