Estimated funds for Workforce Solutions Offices services to job seekers and employers for the upcoming annual award cycles total \$305,973,986* from multiple federal programs (\$301,796,397 or 99% in federal funds, and \$4,177,589 or 1% in state general revenue matching funds), allocated across the state). (*Actual funding depends on final federal award amounts.) Maintenance and operation of the WorkInTexas.com website is also supported by federal funds. TWC's fidelity bonding program is financed 100% with state general revenue through an annual budget of approximately \$8,400; however, for the period July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2023, the program is supplemented by a one-time, \$100,000 federal demonstration grant from the U.S. Department of Labor. The WOTC program is financed 100% by annual federal WOTC funds that total \$214,333 for the period October 1, 2021, through September 30, 2022.

These activities are financed under the TWC Federal Vocational Rehabilitation grant. For the Federal fiscal year 2022 (October 1, 2021, through September 30, 2022), TWC anticipates expending \$242,743,967 in Federal Vocational Rehabilitation funds. Funds appropriated by the State pay a minimum of 21.3% of the total costs (\$65,698,117) under the Vocational Rehabilitation program.
