- 2 On December 20, 2022, the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) approved \$1.5 million in
- 3 Child Care and Development Fund (CCDF) funds for the Texas Rising Star Centralized
- 4 Assessors initiative.

- 6 The Texas Rising Star Centralized Assessors initiative will consolidate the assessment function
- 7 under Texas Rising Star, with all Assessors employed by a single statewide entity rather than
- 8 individual Local Workforce Development Boards, as required by HB 1792 (87th Texas
- 9 Legislature, Regular Session).

- Issue
- On October 31, 2022, TWC issued the Request for Proposals: <u>Texas Rising Star Assessors</u>. The
- eligible applicants who responded and qualified, including the top-scoring applicant, proposed
- 14 contract amounts higher than the amount approved in the FY'23 operating budget. Increasing the
- 15 FY'23 budgeted amount by \$8.4 million will allow TWC to move forward with contract
- 16 negotiations. The Commission can consider adjustments for future year budgets through the
- annual statewide initiatives budget process.

18 **Recommendation**

- 19 Staff recommends increasing the amount of CCDF funds in the FY'23 operating budget for this
- 20 initiative by \$8.4 million, bringing the FY'23 initiative total to \$9.9 million.
