1	<b>Building and Construction Trades Budget Increase</b>

3	Background
4	On July 5, 2022, the Texas Workforce Commission's (TWC) three-member Commission
5	(Commission) approved \$1.8 million in Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)
6	funds for the Building and Construction Trades (BCT) initiative, which provides expedited
7	training to individuals pursuing certification and employment in building and construction
8	careers. The WIOA funds are used to provide training, supplies, and support services for
9	participants. Using an evidence-based grant-making approach, the BCT initiative is TWC's pilot
10	program for an outcomes-based payment model.
11	Issue
12	On February 13, 2023, TWC issued the Building and Construction Trades Request for
13	Applications, and a large number of applicants responded. Because of the quantity of eligible
14	applicants who responded and qualified for a grant award, the budget necessary to fully support
15	the initiative exceeds the \$1.8 million the Commission approved for the BCT initiative in the
16	Fiscal Year 2023 operating budget.
17	Recommendation
18	Staff recommends that the Commission fund all eligible and qualified BCT applicants by
19	increasing the amount of WIOA funds for this initiative from \$1.8 million to \$1,984,590.
