Staff Responses to Commission Work Session Discussion Paper Foster Youth Network

Commission Recommendations

- 1. Seeking approval for staff to bring forward a formal initiative for a Texas Foster Youth Network. The Texas Foster Youth Network initiative will support the development of a statewide network composed of organizations whose missions includes providing services and support to Foster Youth and former Foster Youth (for example, Texas Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS), other Community-Based Organizations (CBOs), Local Workforce Development Boards, and other entities) as well as to create opportunities to share referral and service information that will allow for coordination of services.
- 2. Set aside an amount up to \$4 million dollars to be awarded during Fiscal Year 2025.

Workforce Development Response

1. Staff recommends designating \$4 million in Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) funds to: Procure a platform, including a mobile option, that provides access and referral services for foster youth. Establish a method for collecting and sharing data (ensuring the data system is secure).

Additional Items to Consider

- 1. Programs should conduct a landscape analysis, engage existing member organizations, and invite new partners to collaborate.
- 2. Coordinate with existing federal, state, and local government agencies to ensure collaboration is achieved and duplication is avoided.
