Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act Additional Assistance for Dislocated Workers Discussion Paper

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5 Background

- 6 The Central Texas Workforce Development Board (Board) was awarded a National Dislocated
- 7 Worker Grant (NDWG) by the US Department of Labor Employment and Training
- 8 Administration (DOLETA) on December 1, 2021. The funds are currently leveraged to provide
- 9 employment and training services to dislocated workers in the seven-county region served by the
- 10 Board. Participants in the dislocated worker program also include service members and military
- spouses dislocated from Fort Cavazos US Army base. To date, the Board has served 1,285
- 12 individuals with this grant.
- 13 On August 30, 2023, the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC), on behalf of the Board, applied
- 14 for an Employment Recovery NDWG from DOLETA in the amount of \$7,953,881 to serve a
- 15 minimum of 1,252 dislocated workers during a 24-month period of performance. The primary
- 16 purpose of the project is to address the community impact of the dislocations that occurred over
- 17 the past year—including dislocations of service members and military spouses located at Fort
- 18 Cavazos—that have increased the number of unemployed individuals in Central Texas and
- 19 overburdened the workforce system.

20 Issue

- 21 During the application review process TWC responded to multiple requests for revisions from
- 22 the grant officer; however, DOLETA has not yet sent TWC a notice of approval. The Board must
- 23 continue providing services while the grant application process is underway.
- 24 Staff proposes that the Board use \$750,000 in Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act
- 25 (WIOA) statewide funds during the four-month period, December 2023 through March 2024, to
- 26 provide training in target occupations and support services for new and currently enrolled
- 27 individuals. With the funding, the Board could serve 168 individuals with the following services:
- Career services and case management
- Career skills programs (CSPs)
- 30 Relationship building with CSP staff

31 Decision Point

- 32 Staff recommends providing \$750,000 in additional WIOA statewide funds to the Board to
- 33 provide training in target occupations and support services for new and currently enrolled
- 34 individuals from December 2023 through March 2024.
