

MEETING OF THE TEXAS WORKFORCE COMMISSION

1	Tuesday, February 21, 2023
2	CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Good afternoon, everybody.
3	The meeting is called to order. Mr. Trobman, has anyone signed
4	up for public comment?
5	MR. TROBMAN: Good afternoon, commissioners.
6	Les Trobman, general counsel. We have one person who would like
7	to address the commission this afternoon. Ms. Razvi, if you can
8	go ahead and unmute yourself and introduce yourself, and begin.
9	Ms. Razvi?
10	MS. RAZVI: Can you hear me?
11	MR. TROBMAN: Yes, we can. Go ahead.
12	MS. RAZVI: OK. During this, I will start
13	with my public comment. During this stressful time of pandemic
14	and not having a job, I made an honest mistake on the payment
15	request for the period November 22, to December 26, 2020, by
16	reporting that I was not available to work due to my age, more
17	than 65, and underlying health condition, diabetes. I was
18	unaware that governor of Texas and the director of TWC had
19	withdrawn their earlier decision to exempt older people with
20	underlying health conditions from job search. I corrected that
21	mistake from the payment request starting from December 27,
22	2020, onward. I received two vaccines during March 2021. During
23	the two-week payment request period of April 4 to 10, and April
24	11 to 17, 2021, I got a job and starting working during the week
25	of April 11. I only requested payment for one week, April 4 to

1	10, for the week of 11 to 17, I even reported my estimated
2	income for that one week. On November 19, 2021, I received the
3	booster shot. I was at my full-time work when I received the
4	booster and I'm still working at the same place now. On the
5	decision from Commission Appeals, it reads, as the claimant was
6	released to return to full-time work by her doctor on November
7	19, 2021. This is a wrong statement. I cannot understand how TWC
8	got mixed up with my date of receiving booster, as my date of
9	going back to full-time work. I started full-time work in April
10	2021. TWC stopped paying my unemployment benefit after February
11	20, 2021. I submitted payment requests for seven more weeks
12	after February 20, 2021, until I got the job in April. TWC did
13	not pay me anything for the seven weeks. TWC paid me for
14	November 22, to December 26, 2020, and from December 27, 2020,
15	to February 20, 2021. I made an honest mistake for the first
16	period. I did everything correctly for the second period. Now,
17	TWC wants me to repay for these two periods, and I think it's
18	not fair with me. I want to put this on my public comment on
19	record. Thank you so much.
20	MR. TROBMAN: Thank you. Commissioners,
21	that's all we have for public comment today.
22	MS. RAZVI: Yes.
23	MR. TROBMAN: Thank you.
24	CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Thank you. Good afternoon,
25	Ms. Miller.

1	MS. MILLER: Good afternoon, sir.
2	CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Thank you. Is there any
3	other order of business to come before the commission?
4	COMMISSIONER DEMERSON: None here.
5	COMMISSIONER TREVIÑO: [Inaudible].
6	CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Is there a motion to
7	adjourn?
8	COMMISSIONER DEMERSON: So moved.
9	COMMISSIONER TREVIÑO: I second the motion
10	to adjourn.
11	CHAIRMAN DANIEL: It's been moved and
12	seconded to adjourn, and we are unanimous on that motion. We're
13	adjourned.
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
