1 Tuesday, May 2, 2023 2 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Good morning, everyone. 3 This meeting is called to order. Mr. Trobman, has anyone signed 4 up for public comment? 5 MR. TROBMAN: Good morning, commissioners. 6 Les Trobman, general counsel. We do have one person who has 7 registered for public comment, Robin Harrison. Ms. Harrison, if 8 you're there go ahead and unmute yourself, and begin. 9 MR. TROBMAN: It does not appear Ms. 10 Harrison is here this morning. That's what we got. 11 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: All right. Thank you, Mr. 12 Trobman. Good morning, Ms. Miller. 13 MS. MILLER: Good morning, sir. 14 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Thank you. That's the end 15 of Agenda Items 3 through 7. Let's take a short recess. 16 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: This is Agenda Item 8, 17 Statewide Initiatives Additional Distribution of WIOA Funds to 18 Workforce Development Boards for Teacher Externships. 19 JAMES GOLSAN: Good morning, chairman, 20 commissioners, Mr. Townsend. For the record, for the record 21 James Golsan, Workforce Division. Each year, TWC funds teacher 22 externships program supporting Workforce boards in coordinating 23 externships for teachers and industry. Externships provide

middle school and high school teachers an opportunity to engage

in industry-related activities and learn skills they can in turn

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expose students to in the form of classroom content. Workforce has heard from several boards including current externships participants and boards without an existing externships program that they have a need for externships dollars. We have identified a way to distribute WIOA statewide funds to those boards. Staff seeks direction on distributing one million in WIOA statewide funds to support new and expanded externships program for local Workforce Development boards for summer 2023. I would be happy to answer any questions you all might have.

CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Comments or questions?

COMMISSIONER DEMERSON: Chairman and

commissioner, continuing to receive positive input about the

teacher externship programs and am excited we're doing this

work. I think it's bringing together employers, Workforce, and

economic development, just continue to be excited about what

we're doing in that space.

I think, information about teacher externships. Also hearing
from some employers too that they used them and would like to

Randy, my team and I participated in the Foster Youth 13 conference. We've also been hearing a lot, all the good work 14 that's being done for the foster youth with the agency 15 resources. I would like staff to bring back some recommendations 16 on how we can further strengthen our role in the transition 17 process for foster youth who about to transition out. I would 18 also like for them to look at the Workforce boards, our 19 partnerships with the transition centers, and any other options 20 that we as a commission might consider to inform youth about 21 career paths and strengthen that work. Thank you. 22 MR. TOWNSEND: Yes, Commissioner Treviño. 23 We'll pull that information together and share with the 24 commission. 25 COMMISSIONER TREVIÑO: Thank you.
