

## MEETING OF THE TEXAS WORKFORCE COMMISSION

1	Tuesday, October 10, 2023
2	CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Good morning, all. This
3	meeting is called to order. Mr. Trobman, has anyone signed up
4	for public comment? Thank you very much. Good morning, Ms.
5	Miller.
6	MS. MILLER: Good morning, sir.
7	CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Thank you. We're going to
8	take a short recess. All right, we're back. This is Agenda Item
9	9, Approval of CRP programs to participate in the PPD program.
10	JUAN GARCIA: Good morning, commissioners,
11	Mr. Townsend. Juan Garcia with the Voc Rehab Division. This
12	morning for your consideration and possible action we have seven
13	CRPs that are up for consideration. One is a new CRP that's
14	applying for certification to work with our program, and we also
15	have six—oh, and that new CRP is Tejas Roadrunners out of
16	Huntsville. We also have six CRPs that are up for
17	recertification, and they are Andrews Center in Tyler, Camp
18	County Developmentally Disabled Association in Pittsburg, David
19	& Ivory Ministries in Houston, Lending Helping Hands to Others
20	in Houston, Liberty Proclaimed Ministry in Arlington, and the
21	West Texas Lighthouse for the Blind in San Angelo. Staff
22	recommends the certification and recertification of these CRPs
23	as presented and discussed in the discussion paper. So with that
24	I can answer any questions you might have.
25	CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Any comments or questions?

1 COMMISSIONER DEMERSON: Juan, so Camp County Development Disabled Association, that's Pittsburg, Texas, 2 3 right? 4 JUAN GARCIA: Pittsburg, Texas, yes. 5 COMMISSIONER DEMERSON: All right, OK. No 6 other questions. 7 COMMISSIONER TREVIÑO: No questions. 8 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Is there a motion? 9 COMMISSIONER DEMERSON: Mr. Chairman, I move 10 that we approve the certification and recertification of the 11 following Community Rehabilitation Programs for participation in 12 the Purchasing from People with Disabilities Program as 13 recommended today by staff: Certification of the Tejas 14 Roadrunners nonprofit organization, and recertification of 15 Andrews Center, Camp County Developmental Disabled Association, 16 David & Ivory Ministries, Lending Helping Hands to Others, 17 Liberty Proclaimed Ministry, and the West Texas Lighthouse for 18 the Blind. COMMISSIONER TREVIÑO: I second the motion. 19 20 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: It's been moved and 21 seconded, and the motion carries. Thank you. 22 JUAN GARCIA: Thank you. 23 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: The time is 10:26. Texas 24 Workforce Commission is going into executive session in Room 25 250B to discuss the appointment, employment, evaluation,

1 reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of the executive 2 director, internal auditor, executive staff, or other personnel 3 pursuant to Texas Government Code, Section 550.074(a)(1). 4 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: The executive session has 5 concluded. The time is 10:39. CHAIRMAN DANIEL: Is there any other order 6 7 of business to come before the commission? 8 COMMISSIONER DEMERSON: Chairman, I have a 9 motion I'd like to make. I'd like to move that we approve an 10 increase in the salary of the executive director in the amount 11 of 10 percent effective October 1, 2023. 12 COMMISSIONER TREVIÑO: I second the motion. 13 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: It's been moved and 14 seconded. We're unanimous. 15 COMMISSIONER DEMERSON: OK. Chairman, also 16 I'd like to move that we approve an increase in the salary of 17 the auditor in the amount of three percent effective January 1, 18 2024. COMMISSIONER TREVIÑO: I second the motion. 19 20 CHAIRMAN DANIEL: It's been moved and 21 seconded, and we're unanimous. Any other business to come before 22 the commission? 23 COMMISSIONER DEMERSON: Nothing here. 24 COMMISSIONER TREVIÑO: Nothing here. 25
